The Message

I don't know if all of you know what Scott & Nina do.

Well, Scott is in the United States Air Force. I know that. But I'll be honest, I don't know much else - as what he does is a bit of a secret. I don't know if I should even talking about this - so suffice to say Scott is in the military - somewhere.

Nina, however has chosen a different vocation. She works in a Doctor's office. She is headed back to school with an end goal of becoming a Physician's Assistant. She has chosen her life's work to aid & comfort those in need.

So on the one hand you have my Godson here, day in and day out **Protecting** all of us here. He is out there every day protecting us from the threats of this broken, evil, world that humankind's free will has inflicted on God's perfect creation. It is worth pointing out here that, unlike most of us, Scott lives out the Lord's Prayer each day. It says in the 7th petition of this prayer "And Deliver Us From Evil....". Scott does that every day he reports to work.

And on the other hand you have Nina, who has chosen as her life's work to be a **HEALER**- a nurturer, someone who cares for you, someone who restores you to health. And anyone who knows Nina would say "What else would she do?" In her life, she cares for all. She loves her family, she's everyone's friend. It was written by King David - another Protector - you know, the guy who put a crater in Goliath's forehead....

From the King James Version it reads...

The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want. He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: he leadeth me beside the still waters. He restoreth my soul: he leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake. Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou art with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me. Thou preparest a table before me in the presence of mine enemies: thou anointest my head with oil; my cup runneth over. Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever.

When you hear about "... For thou art with me... thy Rod and Thy staff they comfort me..." King David is talking about how God protects us. The Rod & Staff are symbols of his Might - His Strength, His Love and his willingness to use them to Protect all humanity.

When we hear "He restoreth My Soul", and "Surely Goodness and Mercy shall follow me" the psalmist is talking about how God nurtures us, comforts us, heals us and that we will dwell with our Lord forever. It talks about how he will take care of us FOREVER. We will live in his house for all eternity in his Kingdom.

The point is - that the essence of our Lord is the same as what the 2 of you have chosen to do. The Lord is our ultimate Protector and Healer. You are doing the Lord's work in your lives. That should resonate well with you. It certainly delights your Heavenly Father.

So while that is interesting, what does that have to do with today? Well here's the TRIFECTA. You know we had to work horse racing into this somewhere.....

It means that in about 3 minutes you start your life as a married couple. And starting today, both of you will also need to endeavor to PROTECT and NURTURE your marriage that God creates this day. The world is a sinful place, Satan can be anywhere, and we are not perfect.

And that means that in the decades of life you have in front of you, you will need to PROTECT your marriage. You will need to NURTURE your marriage. Godson, sometime, somewhere, you will need to heal Nina. Nina, sometime, somewhere, you will need to protect Scott - and Vice Versa.

Falling in Love comes easily - but Staying in Love cannot be taken for granted. Commit to your marriage. Love each other by embracing where you are different. Be willing to forgive, be quick to forget. Deal lovingly with the challenges life always seems to throw you - together. These are precisely the ideals you are committing to - in God's presence - right now......
